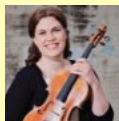

INFORMATION AND POLICIES

Eligibility

- This is a supplementary group program. It is required that students are studying privately with a Suzuki teacher.
- Students must be studying at Suzuki Violin, Viola or Cello Book 4 level or higher.
- Students must be in 6th grade and up, and at least 11 years old.
- Acceptance is based on student audition and private teacher recommendation. Technical skills, quality of performance, memorization skills, music reading skills, character, and commitment to the student's instrument and the Suzuki philosophy will be considered.

Auditions

- Video requirements: memorized performance two polished pieces from the Suzuki literature in Suzuki Book 4 or higher.
- Audition videos must be submitted online via YouTube link.
- Teachers must submit recommendations directly to Dolce Music Studio.

Attendance

- Attendance at all workshops, classes and concerts is required. Every performer plays an essential role in the group. Full participation is necessary to create a quality performance. If classes and rehearsals are missed, the faculty will decide whether or not the student may perform in the concerts or tours.
- Student absences cannot be credited or refunded. No make-up classes are given for classes missed by students for any reason.
- If you must miss a class, please call, email, or text the faculty as soon as possible. We will worry about your safety if you do not show up.
- Do not attend class when ill. Please do not pass on contagious illnesses to the faculty and the other students and families in the group.

Tuition

- Tuition includes classes, rehearsals, concerts, selected meals, and one tour group t-shirt. Concert uniforms and out-of-town tour expenses will be in addition to tuition.
- Tuition may be paid by major credit card, check or cash. Make checks payable to Dolce Music Studio. There is a \$35 fee for returned checks.

Other Fees

- Music and materials: It is expected that students own the appropriate volumes of the Suzuki literature and the accompanying recordings. Parents will be responsible for sheet music costs for concert repertoire outside the Suzuki literature. Photocopying/xeroxing of copyrighted materials is illegal and will not be allowed, with the exception of permanently out-of-print music. CD's and cassette recordings are also copyrighted materials. Copying of published CD's is also illegal and will not be allowed.

Discontinuing Classes

- It is assumed that when a student begins, that they will be a member of the group for the entire season. If it becomes necessary to discontinue membership in the group, tuition will not be refunded.
- We may have to dismiss a student if any of these circumstances occur: failure to pay tuition on time, failure to comply with group policies, uncooperative or disruptive attitude, lack of progress due to insufficient practice or unfulfilled requirements.

Preparation

- Students are expected to prepare and memorize the concert repertoire before the first read-thru.
- All performances will be memorized. No music or music stands will be used.
- Bowings, fingerings, tempo and stylistic interpretation must match the group and will be decided by the Dolce Music Studio faculty.

Attire

- Nice casual attire is appropriate for classes, rehearsals and workshops.
- Casual concert attire: 2017-18 tour group t-shirt, blue jeans, sneakers or casual shoes, and socks. (Please try to match the color of your socks with either your jeans or your shoes.) In cold weather, layer UNDER your t-shirt. Long sleeves are fine. Coordinate colors with the colors in the t-shirt. Girls: hair pulled back neatly in a ponytail, simple & natural makeup, no jewelry except for small earrings.
- Formal concert attire: Girls: royal blue tour group blouse, tour group long black palazzo pants, plain black flats, matching black knee-hi hose, hair pulled back in a half-pony (scrunchie/hairtie/rubber band matching the color of your hair as close as possible) with tour group sparkly blue hair clip. Please make sure undergarments are appropriate for the blouse. Please keep makeup simple and natural. No jewelry, except for small earrings and your hair clip. Boys: tour group blue vest and blue tie, your own white dress shirt, black dress pants, black dress shoes and black socks.
